# SantaCaliGon Days Festival 2023 Presented by: Xfinity



Business to Education Connector The SantaCaliGon Festival doesn't happen by magic, nor in a couple of weeks of planning. Under the leadership of Amy Knipp, the director of all things SCG, meetings begin in the month of May, to "hammer out" the details of the fifty-one-year festival. Yet, this isn't the beginning. On the final day of the festival, Monday of Labor Day Weekend, vendors gather at the Chamber to reserve space for the following year. Within weeks, the Entertainment Committee is already reviewing the entertainment for the following year.

The SCG Festival hosts hundreds of volunteers, who work together, to bring this awesome entertainment to the community. Terri and Greg Steele have served over 25 years as volunteers. Their three daughters, Amy, Lindsey and Ashley continue the family tradition in volunteering at festival with their families.

One of our finest and most faithful volunteers, Wayne Stewart, comes from a great distance to volunteer at SCG. Grow-

ing up in Brookside, Wayne knew little about Independence. After moving to Independence and becoming involved in the Independence Chamber of Commerce, he became involved in a variety of programs. One which was the D.A.R.E. program. He participated in a project for D.A.R.E., "Dunk a Cop" at the festival and that was the beginning of Wayne's participation in SCG. Wayne, like many of the volunteers, uses vacation time

to volunteer at the festival year after year. Wayne stated, "Being involved in the community has been one of the most rewarding experiences of my lifetime. Independence welcomed me with open arms, and I have made a great deal of lasting friendships in Independence".



Other volunteers like Eric Knipp, started out as a volunteer at the Knights of Columbus booth. He was recruited to work the "Main Stage" and has enjoyed every moment for fifteen years. Beth Franklin moved to Independence, joined the Chamber, and quickly developed strong relationships in our community that led to 10 years of volunteer service to the festival. Independence natives, Jonathan Zerr, Troy Kuhnert, and Jeff Benson continue to support our community through active involvement and a genuine love for the festival.

When asked about favorite memories from their times of volunteering at SCG, many refer to the entertainers who performed at the festival. Dave Evans spoke about how surprised Wynonna Judd was regarding the fantastically large audience who came to hear her sing. There have also been times of great fun for the volunteers, as well. Eric Knipp recalls leaving his keys in his SCG golf cart

and finding it wrapped in duct tape and plastic wrap and tied to a tree.

The SantaCaliGon Festival wouldn't exist without the hundreds of individuals, who spend their time, energy and talent ensuring that everyone else has a wonderful time. As Beth said, "I can't imagine spending my Labor Day weekend anywhere else!"

We couldn't do it without you! Hats off to all those volunteers on the SCG organizing committee...as well as the many others who make SCG such a great experience for our community!



The annual SantaCaliGon® Days Festival, held Labor Day Weekend, commemorates the origin of the Santa Fe, California, and Oregon trails in Independence during the country's great westward expansion by early pioneers. The first SantaCaliGon Days Festival was held in 1940 to celebrate the unique heritage of the City of Independence as the starting point of the three trails. A second celebration was held after World War II in 1947. The festival was not held again until 1973. Today, it celebrates music, tradition, family, and fun! More than 300,000 attendees spend Labor Day Weekend at the region's oldest and largest festival.







