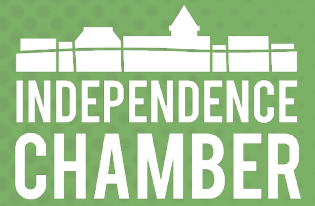

## Meet Laurie Carpenter!

Authentic Life Clinical Counseling  
& Wellness

Water running down her face, sitting on a small makeshift stool, waiting for the next person to hit the bullseye, throwing Laurie Carpenter into the water, is a dream come true for her. Laurie is the owner and therapist of Authentic Life Clinical Counseling & Wellness. When she hits the water, she is making money for her Non-profit organization!

Laurie grew up in Independence, experiencing life struggles as she attended Bridger Middle School and William Chrisman High School. She knew she was not moving in the direction she desired, but was unsure about the steps needed to get away from the issues impacting her.

Her defining moment came in a subtle tugging by God on her heart, as she listened to His call, finding her purpose. She began attending Maple Woods, where she graduated as a recipient of the Trustee Transfer Scholarship, which recognized her as the non-traditional student of the year.



She credits the assistance of others, school counselors and social workers, as directing her desire to help others, just as she had been helped. After receiving her Master's Degree in Social Work, she began to work, gaining experience. She was a therapist at Lakewood Counseling Services, which was operating under the umbrella of the University Health Care System, in the drug addiction recovery program. She also was the Team Lead for the Comprehensive Mental Health Center's Residential Care Facility for SPMI (Severe and persistent Mental illness). Laurie gained additional experience as the Lead Therapist for the Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP) with Signature Psychiatric Hospital in the Northland.

Returning to her hometown of Independence, she wanted to start a home-based mental health practice in her home, using telehealth, which proved to be a "brilliant" move. When Covid became a reality and proved to be an excellent venue during that time, meeting the needs of her clients, in a different modality. Her business continued to grow, adding therapists and interns. During the December, 2021 Living Windows presentation on the Independence Square, she found an open space and began to seriously consider moving to a "bricks and mortar" location. After opening her business, she and her staff noticed a lot of people were calling for services, however, were unable to afford them.

# Member Spotlight Continued...

Again, Laurie began to tackle the issue of unaffordable mental health care! She attempted to find other organizations who would contribute to the funding of her non-profit, funding for mental health services. She found Diana Marshall, from her non-profit: Someone That Cares (STC). Diana, was working with the River of Refuge, a transitional living program for families, at that time. Together with other community minded friends, they started, The Authentic Life Foundation. Diana and Laurie began to search for other organizations, who were interested in helping folks with mental health issues, in our community. She then found Life Church, East Kansas City, who granted Laurie's non-profit a small grant. By the beginning of January, 2023, the non-profit had been formed and recognized by the Federal Government as a 501(C)3.



The foundational philosophy of Authentic Life Clinical Counseling & Wellness is: "All human beings have strengths. With the help of a therapist, the client can define and use those strengths to overcome the obstacles which are challenging them from living the life they desire." Laurie's personal mission is to help continue and grow the number of professional helpers who serve the needs of others. Laurie is hopeful that the partnerships will continue, allowing those who could benefit from counseling services needed to live a healthier, more productive life. The Dunking tank at the SantaCaliGon Festival was done for the benefit of The Authentic Life Foundation, as well as getting the word to the community that Authentic Life Clinical Counseling & Wellness was open

Laurie and her fellow therapists serve a broad variety of patient needs. Anxiety, Depression, Substance Abuse, Trauma, Suicidal Ideation, ADHD, Autism, and Crisis Counseling, as well as receiving referrals from Mental Health Hospitals provide the core client base for their clinic. She is happily married, parented two now-grown children and is providing care for her father, who currently lives with her and her husband. Laurie told me: "There was a moment I realized that my traumatic childhood had damaged me and I needed to break the cycle of generational trauma. Everyone deserves hope!"
