Finding your passion sometimes takes time...

Early in 2024, the Independence Redevelopment Committee held a three day Workshop at the Independence Chamber of Commerce Board Room. There were many designs and renderings of various creative ideas around the room, however, my eye was drawn to the work of a local architect, Dan Pierce. My interest in architecture has always been a case of valuing the marvel of creations I have viewed, but having not a clue as to how the images were completed. However, I wanted to meet Dan and discover the reasons he entered his profession. I found his career journey to be unusual and inspiring.

Dan grew up in Lee's Summit, MO and graduated from Lee Summit High School. He, like many of his fellow LSHS graduates, went to UCM in the fall, majoring in Computer Information Systems. One and a half years later, he was coding, coding, coding...and he couldn't see himself doing that for the rest of his life. Following conversations with his fraternity advisor, Bob Showers, Dan switched to Finance and graduated from college.



Upon graduation, Dan moved to St. Louis, MO and found a job as a personal banker, which led to his involvement with mortgage sales. Dan found that mortgage sales were not a great fit for his personal skills, so he returned to the Kansas City area and worked with an insurance company. He found the job to include many of the benefits he desired...a car and a computer, as well as traveling around the metro, yet his creative side of life felt 'incomplete''.

Introduced to his wife, Chelsea, by his college friend, Angie Judy of Independence, Dan was married in 2010. His wife sensed, Dan's career possibilities were leaving him unfulfilled. Chelsea encouraged Dan to return to college, to follow the career aspirations he had always felt. A conversation with his father-In-law changed the course of Dan's life. His FIL asked him why he was reluctant to return to school and Dan told him, he was in an "OK" career and would be six years older if he returned to school and obtained his architectural degree. His FIL wisely answered, "You will be that many years older anyway, and wouldn't you rather have a career that you found enjoyable and interesting?"

Dan spent about a year and a half finishing his electives at Johnson County Community College, building his portfolio, before attending Kansas University and earning his master's in architecture. He particularly enjoyed his Architectural History class. He was selected to participate in a yearlong internship of studying abroad in Paris, with a professor who had lots of connections in the world of Architecture. The professor was quite critical in the beginning, yet during the year, he and Dan formed a strong relationship of respect and appreciation. Additionally, Dan was placed in the international architectural firm of Jean Nouvel, in Paris, who's cinematic and storytelling attributes are woven together to present a unique creative process which greatly influenced Dan's presentation skills.

Currently, Dan works with a firm GLMV, which recently rebranded to Tessere. This Wichita, Kansas firm has been in operation since 1919. He has enjoyed a great experience with Tessere, and has great appreciation, in part because this firm "kept all its'people employed during the Pandemic" as well as the opportunity to grasp and understand the visualization studio process, he has previously enjoyed to a high level. Much of the architectural industry limits the visualization process approach, because it is very time consuming to the architectural firm, for so much time to be devoted to the completion of the entire process.

Dan shares three children with Chelsea: Blair, age 11, Graham, age 9 and Sylvia, age 6. He has been active in designing some of the structures in Independence and surrounding areas, as well. He finds his career so very rewarding, as he can see his projects, and their impact on the community's use. He has also found great satisfaction in knowing each of his building designs affects the community spirit in a positive manner. Dan is happy to be a part of the Community of Independence, as well as the Chamber of our city. Dan believes that our community, in Independence, is on the cusp of seeing the vision of possibilities, which can bring newfound interest to our city! Dan is in partnership at the Independence branch of Tessere with Chad Pruente and Riley Griffith.

Dan was a pleasure to meet and interview! He is an authentic and delightful young man and gives me great hope in the unlimited potential of possibilities for my beloved city!
