

Member Spotlight

Independence's Own "Wonder Woman"

Terri Steele, a member of the Board of the Chamber of Commerce in Independence, is known for many reasons! Terri was born in Atlantic, Iowa, a small city of about 10,000 people, located between Omaha, Nebraska, and Des Moines, Iowa. She grew up as the only child of parents Don and Shirley Stelpflug, both of whom worked at Walnut Grove, a livestock and feed company. Like many of us, Terri grew up in an idyllic place where her childhood was filled with wonderful memories.

While returning from vacation during her late high school years, her parents asked if she wanted to see the campus of Northwest Missouri State University in Maryville. She immediately fell in love with the campus, and the college became a tradition in the Steele household, as she later met her husband, Greg, there as well. He was from Milam, Missouri, and asked her out seven times before she finally agreed to go on a date with him. Greg was older and a "frat boy," so Terri wanted to be sure about this guy before giving him a chance. After graduation, Greg moved to rural eastern Iowa to manage a feed elevator, while Terri moved to Cedar Rapids, where she worked as a manager at a large tax

firm. They married, and shortly afterward, Greg took a new job as an underwriter in the insurance industry, marking the beginning of their journey to Kansas City.

After moving to Kansas City, Terri obtained a job at Guardian Life and worked behind the scenes in financial planning. The sales manager at Guardian Life, Bill Evans, later partnered with her to launch their own firm, Evans and Steele Financial, in 1994.

Over the years, Terri experienced the loss of her grandparents, then her father, and eventually her mother. These life transitions brought valuable lessons, and she found deep support from her parents' financial advisor, who even traveled from Atlantic, Iowa, to Kansas City to meet with her. Inspired by that experience, Terri has continued to weave her family into the heart of her business, which has truly become a family affair.

Her daughter Amy joined Evans and Steele about fifteen years ago, and her daughter Lindsey came on board about five years ago. Both women have earned their licenses (triple-licensed, in fact, all three women have seven)! Not to leave out her third daughter, Ashley, she's a manager of events for the law firm Polsinelli.

Thanks to Terri's cheerful and joyous personality, her business has recently expanded to the Boston, Massachusetts area. She met a like-minded woman at a Women's Financial Conference in Fort Lauderdale in 2024. Both were keynote speakers, and Terri encouraged her new friend to leave her bank advisement role and launch her own financial planning practice under the Evans and Steele umbrella. One thing that brings Terri tremendous pride? Evans and Steele has never advertised. Their entire business has grown through good old-fashioned "word of mouth"!



I found Terri's business principles to be a great match for the wonderful woman I know Terri to be ...principles based on her values of watching her parents conduct business, her own business experience of thirty-one years, and then to be a business and community leader and living by those same honest and life-affirming ideas! 
- Getting to know the client and understanding their own life plan at the most personal level
